## MANAGING PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS (FOR COUNCILLORS)

This flowchart provides councillors with guidance when making decisions about private interests that may conflict with their public duty.

This flowchart should be used in conjunction with the following authoritative sources of information on these matters:

- the Local Government Act (1993) ('the Act');
- the Local Government (General) Regulations 2015;
- the Local Government (Meeting Procedure) Regulations 2015; and
- the council's Code of Conduct for councillors;

If a councillor is uncertain about a specific matter or decision, they should seek further guidance from:

- the council's Mayor;
- the council's General Manager;
- the Local Government Division; and/or
- the Local Government Association of Tasmania.
