Employees become 'agents' for CIPO, and are tasked with an 'assignment' to uncover the source of a recent information breach. With interactive video scenarios and activities, the e-learning module engages employees and raises awareness of the key risks associated with information misuse in the public sector.



Employees will be able to:

- explain how work information can be improperly handled
- describe the consequences of using work information improperly, including the impact of unintentional misuse
- recognise the key risk areas for improper handling of work information in the public sector, and how this may relate to their role.
